The outdoor match season on the APR is pretty much wrapped up for the year with the only sports continuing through the cold weather months being SCSA and Fast and Furious steel matches. See OCSC dates on Practiscore.com for match schedules and registration.

Indoor Range is busy with Pins, PPC, Bullseye and IDPA / USPSA practices. See the range page for days and times.

There is some cleanup on the outdoor 10/25/50/100-yard ranges that will be taking place over next month or so with moving fill to the berms and doing some additional contouring work. Once spring hits we will finish off that range with the approved range division effectively eliminating range closures for events and allowing a much more efficient use of the range. Thanks to all that have helped with this significant project to date.

Fall / Winter PPC Season - Indoor range – Thursdays from 5:30 to 9:30 PM, October 3, 2024 to March 27, 2025, and Mondays from 8:30 AM to 12:00, October 7th 2024 to March 31, 2025.

Fall / Winter USPSA / IDPA Weekly Practice - Indoor range on Saturday mornings from 8:00 AM to noon, November 2nd 2024 to March 29th.

The Action Pistol Range is very active with matches occurring each week through November and possibly December if the cold weather holds off. Steel Challenge, USPSA, IDPA, and various rim fire matches are on the schedule.

Indoor Range starting Saturdays in November through March will be closed from 8:00 a.m. until noon for IDPA, USPSA practices. Also the blizzard blast indoor match will have the indoor range closed from Thursday January 23 from 8:00 p.m. until Sunday the 26th at 5:00 p.m.

Lots of good things happening at OCSC shotgun!

First, mark your calendars! The Shotgun banquet is Saturday, March 8th. Great food. Raffles galore. Good friends. Annual fundraiser for the OCS shotgun club.

Second, the shotgun banquet will culminate with the raffle drawing for the Gun of the Year... a brand-new, 12 gauge, Browning Citori O/U model 825 Sporting (30" barrel; extended chokes; full and modified choke tubes are included).

Tickets for the banquet and raffle tickets for the Gun of the Year will go on sale in late November.

Third, you will notice a new fence atop the berm on the shotgun range (replaces the curtains). This improves the appearance of the OCSC grounds and complies with EGLE requirements.

OCSC shotgun is open Tuesday and Wednesday nights from 6 pm - 10 pm and Saturday and Sunday from 11 am - 4 pm. Ammunition is available for 20 gauge (lead only) and 12 gauge (lead and steel); \$11/box for lead (20 & 12 gauge) and \$13/box for steel (12 gauge only at this time).

The club is open to members and non-members (pricing for non-members is slightly higher for games); there are always "seasoned" shooters willing to help you with your shotgun skills.

.22 Cal., Half-Pins

### Open to the Public!

**Where:** The O.C.S.C. Range House  
4770 Waterford Road Clarkston, MI 48346

**When:** Sunday evenings, 6 PM to ~9 PM  
Sept. 15 thru Dec. 15 (Skipping Nov. 24)  
Feb. 16 thru May 18 (Skipping Apr. 20)

**Cost:** \$5 Members, \$10 Non-Members

This is a "Fun-Shoot", for .22LR pistols, but, we will allow .22 LR (magazine fed.) rifles.  
**Typical Equipment:** Ruger Mark I, II, III, IV, 22/45; Hi Standard and other similar semi-auto pistols, and .22 Cal. Revolvers. Red Dot or Iron Sights.

**Required:** Eye and hearing protection.

**Objective and course of fire:** Clear the tables as quickly as possible. Range: 21 Ft.

6- tables per shooter per set. (Typically 2-3 sets per night.) Up to 4-shooters on the line.

The longest time is thrown out, and the remaining 5 times are averaged for your score.

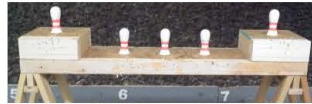
The maximum time for a table is 15-seconds, cleared or not.

Pins must be OFF the table, but not necessarily on the floor to stop the clock.

Shooters start at a "Low Ready" position, waiting for the start buzzer.

No magazine changes, but you are allowed to clear jams.
